

## Sample Full-time Schedule

Please note that this is a sample schedule. Specific course offerings may vary from quarter to quarter.

Classes are held evenings and occasional weekends. Classes are held at the Professional Development Center in Tacoma.

### Orientation

Prior to the first class, you attend an orientation. Registration, e-mail accounts and student services information are covered. You will also be introduced to online learning for the Mansfield classes.

### Courses

For specific examples of the course curriculum, please see the program fact sheet, available from the Admissions Office. In this program, you must complete 48.5 credits to earn the degree, and usually do so within eight to nine quarters, attending part time.

The program consists of both required courses and elective options related to Library Media topics. You take library endorsement classes from both Antioch University Seattle and Mansfield University and you take an inquiry sequence of classes that satisfy the master's in education requirement from Antioch University Seattle.

### Inquiry Project

During the final stages of the program, you complete an inquiry project, integrating your academic and professional interests in school libraries.
