

Sample Full-time Schedule

Please note that this is a sample schedule. Specific course offerings may vary from quarter to quarter.

Classes are held evenings and occasional weekends. You register for classes that meet your interests.

Orientation

Prior to the first week of class, you attend the Center for Programs in Education orientation. Registration, e-mail accounts and student services information are covered, in addition to specific sessions designed for each education program.

Courses

For specific examples of the course curriculum, please see the program fact sheet, available from the Admissions Office. In this program, you must complete 48 credits to earn the degree, and usually do so within eight to nine quarters, attending part time.

You design a program to meet your professional goals and interests. You will be required to take a series of core courses in the early stages of the program. Then, you may choose elective courses that correspond to the concentration or endorsement program you wish to pursue.

Concentration or Endorsement Options

You have a number of specialization options to focus your studies in ways that match your professional interests. You may choose to take electives in a particular subject area (concentration) or pursue an endorsement track that leads to certification in Washington state. Review the list below.
